Impact of buttons

- ▶ What is added if each is enabled
- ▶ What is available (perhaps surprising) even if not enabled
- ▶ What to beware about enabling or not

Some myths and misunderstandings

- ▶ What the monitor is and is not
- ▶ When you should and should NOT fear its impact
- ▶ Why it's not perfect: wrong and right answers

Some other points to cover

- ▶ Alerts
- ▶ Settings
- ▶ Other related tools:
 - multiserver monitor, server manager, admin API
- ▶ What's changed in CF 9 Updater 1:
 - new web server alternative (not now "running outside of process")
 - easier control from CF Admin
