- The CF "Package Management" feature and cfpm tool offer more than most may realize
 - Sure, it helps "manage packages"...and some will wonder, "what does that mean?"
- ▶ In this talk, we'll discuss them, their history and evolution (since CF2021)
 - Using the feature to manage CF updates, setup CF instances, more
- Can also be used for automation, not just of packages/updates
 - But also deployment of CF containers
- And feature to scan your CF code base to find packages needed
- ▶ We'll discuss the cli tool, the related admin UI page, and more

WHAT IS THIS "PACKAGE MANAGEMENT"?

- ► Its introduction in CF2021, its goal
- ► The 50+ "packages" (or "modules")
- ► Its use with CF zip or full installer
- ► Its use via CF Admin UI page
 - ► or cfpm cli tool...

THE CFPM CLI TOOL

- Available as an interactive shell
 - Or can use imperative arguments
- ► Quick demo of both

MANAGING PACKAGES

- Adding/removing installed packages (some/all)
 - Install / uninstall cfpm commands
- Listing packages
 - ▶ list/listall
- Getting information on packages
 - ▶ info

UPDATING CF

- Updating packages (some or all)
 - ▶ update
 - Update technote has table tracking if any packages were updated
- ► Its use for performing offline CF updates
 - CF update technote shows steps
- Downloading repo
 - ▶ downloadrepo
 - Setting repo download path
 - ▶ updaterepopath
- Purging "felix" cache (via cli or folder mgt)
 - ▶ purgecache
 - cfusion/bin/felix-cache

MANAGING PACKAGES ACROSS INSTANCES

- Exporting/importing current packages
 - > export / import
 - ► CF Admin UI
- Automate packages implemented in CF containers
 - Point to list of packge names or file of export results, using available environment vars
 - ▶ installModules [list | all]
 - ▶ importModules [file]

IDENTIFYING PACKAGES NEEDED FOR YOUR APP

- Have you wondered what packages you may need?
- > cfpm scan feature
 - ► Fails in cf2021 after update 5
 - CF2023 changed to remove need of url
- ► Available scanandinstall

EVOLUTION OF THE PM/CFPM FEATURE

- Installing package now implements version for your current CF update level
 - Rather than <u>latest</u> package version
 - Since Oct 2023 CF updates (for 2021 and 2023)
 - See doc links to follow
- ► Again, removal of "CFSERVERURL" in scan
 - ► Since CF2023
